5) A vase can hold 55 flowers. If a florist had 313 flowers, how many flowers would be in the last vase that isn't full?
6) Olivia bought 526 bottles of water when they were on sale. If she wanted to drink exactly 40 bottles a day, how many more bottles would she need?
7) Gary had 600 marbles he's putting into bags with 94 in each bag. How many marbles will he have in the bag that isn't full?
8) Quincy is trying to earn 667 dollars for some new video games. If he charges 99 dollars to mow a lawn, how many lawns will he need to mow to earn the money?
9) A cafeteria was putting milk cartons into crates. They had 200 cartons and were putting them into crates with 49 cartons in each create. How many full crates would they end up with?
10) A movie store had 453 movies they were putting on 92 shelves. If the owner wanted to make sure each shelf had the same number of movies how many more movies would he need?
11) Olivia had 373 photos to put into photo albums. If each page holds 92 photos, how many full pages will she have?
12) A restaurant needs to buy 754 new plates. If each box has 47 plates in it, how many boxes will they need to buy?
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
